4. "Lightning Round"

Fr. Sakowski explained that he now has extra duties as Dean and as a representative on the Personnel Council. He is grateful to the way that staff and volunteers are stepping up to care for the parishes.

Sam Kuehn reported that he has enjoyed singing in the choir and helping with parish socials. John Kuehn expressed a desire to see more children singing in the choir. Susan Fiser reported that she has been more active in the Chippewa Valley Young Adult group. Several council members were unaware that this group exists. Fr. Thelen is working on completing the cemetery landscaping project, which will bring in a mix of deciduous and evergreens. Lisa Olson requested that the parish look into safety issues and the possibility of marriage retreats. Tom Falbo reported that the task force has met to plan Lent and the Paschal Triduum; he will now be working on training for the altar servers and scheduling for all ministries. He also reported positive feedback on the *Welcome to Our Church* booklets in the pews. Mike Quirk reported the need for better plowing at the bottom of the driveway. Marj Messerschmidt reported broken glass on the couples list for wedding anniversaries; if it happens again it would be helpful if someone would just say something.

Group Discussion – Lent, Triduum, and Easter in 2018
 --40 Hour Devotion (Feb 14-16) – The signup sheets are at both parishes for parishioners to attend adoration for one hour or more between 8 p.m. on Feb. 14 through 4 p.m. Feb. 16.

- --Stations Stations will be held at each parish, Friday's at 7 p.m. at SM and 5 p.m. at SR followed by soup and sandwiches. The Spanish community would like to be walking outside with someone carrying the cross.
- --Retreat –Father Sakowski is proposing an evangelizing retreat for SM & SR ministers (ushers, lectors, EMHC, greeters. etc.) on Saturday, March 24, approximately noon to 3 p.m. The retreat would be focused on encouraging parish members to be missionary disciples and retraining those in ministry roles.
